Chapter 2: Scholarship Overview

The scholarship aims to encourage academic excellence while making quality medical education more accessible to deserving candidates across India.

2.2 Scholarship Objectives

The objectives of the Pulse Scholarship Aptitude Test (PSAT) are to:

- Recognize and reward academically deserving medical aspirants.
- Reduce the financial burden associated with pursuing MBBS Abroad.

2.3 Scholarship Pool

The scholarship fund shall be distributed among eligible students based on merit and scholarship category, subject to successful document verification and compliance with all scholarship policies. Scholarship benefits shall be applicable only in accordance with the Scholarship Activation Policy described in this Rulebook.

In addition, eligible students may receive special fee concessions under the Defence Scholarship and Women in Medicine Scholarship categories, subject to eligibility.

2.5 Scholarship Categories

Gold Scholar

1 Student · Scholarship Value: Rs 1,00,000. Awarded to the highest-ranked eligible candidate in PSAT 2026.

Silver Scholar

1 Student · Scholarship Value: Rs 75,000. Awarded to the second highest-ranked eligible candidate.

Bronze Scholar

1 Student · Scholarship Value: Rs 50,000. Awarded to the third highest-ranked eligible candidate.

Merit Scholar

91 Students · Scholarship Value: Rs 25,000 each. Awarded to eligible candidates ranked after the top three based on the final merit list.

Defence Scholarship Benefit

Applicants belonging to eligible Defence families may receive an additional 20% concession on the applicable Pulse Education consultancy fee, subject to successful verification of supporting documents.

Women in Medicine Scholarship Benefit

Eligible female candidates may receive an additional 15% concession on the applicable Pulse Education consultancy fee as part of the Women in Medicine initiative.

2.6 Scholarship Coverage

The scholarship is intended to reduce the financial burden associated with the MBBS Abroad admission process. Scholarship benefits may be adjusted against applicable:

- Admission consultancy charges

The scholarship does not cover:

- University tuition fees

- Any charges payable directly to the university unless specifically mentioned by the Scholarship Committee.

2.7 Scholarship Validity

The scholarship shall:

- Be valid only for the 2026 MBBS Abroad admission cycle.
- Be applicable only upon successful admission through Pulse Education.
- Be non-transferable.
- Be non-refundable.
- Not be redeemable for cash.

- Lapse automatically if admission is not completed within the validity period.

Chapter 3: Eligibility Criteria

3.1 Introduction

The Pulse Scholarship Aptitude Test (PSAT) 2026 has been established to identify and support deserving students aspiring to pursue MBBS Abroad through a transparent and merit-based scholarship program.

To maintain fairness and ensure that scholarship benefits reach eligible candidates, all applicants must satisfy the eligibility criteria prescribed in this chapter. Meeting the eligibility requirements does not automatically guarantee the award of a scholarship. Scholarships shall be awarded only after successful completion of the examination, document verification, merit evaluation, and compliance with all scholarship policies.

Applicants are advised to read this chapter carefully before submitting their application.

3.2 Eligibility Criteria

An applicant must satisfy all of the following eligibility requirements:

1. Nationality

The applicant must be an Indian Citizen. Applicants may be required to submit a valid Government-issued identity document as proof of nationality during the verification process.

2. NEET Qualification

The applicant must have qualified NEET UG in any one of the following examination years: NEET UG 2024, NEET UG 2025, NEET UG 2026. Only candidates meeting the minimum qualifying percentile prescribed for their respective category shall be considered eligible. Applicants who have only appeared for NEET but have not qualified shall not be eligible.

3. Academic Qualification

Applicants must have successfully completed Class XII (10+2) or an equivalent examination recognized by the appropriate educational authority. The applicant must have studied Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology, and English. The applicant must have secured a minimum aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, and Biology (PCB) under the latest National Medical Commission (NMC) regulations.

4. Eligibility for MBBS Abroad

Applicants must satisfy the prevailing eligibility requirements prescribed by the National Medical Commission (NMC) for pursuing MBBS Abroad. Applicants are responsible for ensuring that they fulfill all applicable eligibility requirements before proceeding with admission.

5. Registration Requirement

Applicants must register online for PSAT 2026 before the prescribed deadline, complete the application form accurately, express their intent to pursue MBBS Abroad through Pulse Education, and successfully submit all mandatory information before the application closes. Incomplete applications may not be considered.

6. Document Submission

Applicants must upload all required documents during registration or within the prescribed verification timeline. Only clear, authentic, and valid documents shall be accepted. Failure to submit the required documents within the stipulated timeline may result in rejection of the application.

3.3 Special Scholarship Categories

A. Defence Scholarship

Applicants belonging to Defence families may be eligible for an additional 20% concession on the applicable Pulse Education consultancy fee. Eligible categories may include:

- Children of Serving Armed Forces Personnel
- Children of Retired Armed Forces Personnel
- Ex-Servicemen Families
- Martyrs' Families (subject to verification)

Applicants claiming this benefit must submit valid supporting documents.

B. Women in Medicine Scholarship

To encourage greater participation of women in medical education, eligible female applicants may receive an additional 15% concession on the applicable Pulse Education consultancy fee. This concession is applicable only after successful verification and scholarship approval.

3.4 Required Documents

- Any other document requested by the Scholarship Committee

3.5 Verification Process

All shortlisted applicants shall undergo a verification process. Verification may include:

- Identity Verification
- Academic Qualification Verification
- NEET Qualification Verification
- Defence Certificate Verification
- Document Authenticity Verification
- MBBS Abroad Eligibility Verification

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to seek clarification or additional documents whenever required.

3.6 Ineligible Applicants

The following applicants shall not be eligible to participate in PSAT 2026:

- Students who have not qualified NEET UG.
- Applicants who fail to meet the minimum academic eligibility prescribed under the latest NMC regulations.

- Students who submit incomplete applications.
- Applicants who fail to upload mandatory documents.
- Students providing false, misleading, or fabricated information.
- Applicants submitting forged or altered documents.
- Candidates involved in impersonation or examination malpractice.
- Applicants submitting multiple registrations using different identities.
- Students who have already secured admission to an MBBS program for the 2026 academic session before the scholarship results are announced.

3.7 Disqualification

An applicant shall be disqualified at any stage if:

- Any information submitted is found to be false.
- Documents are found to be forged or manipulated.
- Examination malpractice is detected.
- Identity verification fails.
- Required documents are not submitted within the prescribed timeline.
- Eligibility criteria are not fulfilled.
- Any rule or policy of the scholarship program is violated.

Disqualification may occur before or after the declaration of results. If scholarship benefits have already been approved, they may be withdrawn upon discovery of any violation.

3.8 Responsibilities of Applicants

- Reading the Information Bulletin carefully before applying.
- Providing complete and accurate information.
- Uploading authentic documents.
- Meeting all prescribed deadlines.
- Keeping their registered mobile number and email active throughout the scholarship process.
- Regularly checking official communications issued by the Scholarship Committee.
- Complying with all rules and instructions issued by the organizers.

Failure to comply with these responsibilities may affect the applicant's eligibility.

3.9 Reservation of Rights

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to:

- Verify any information submitted by an applicant.
- Request additional documents at any stage.
- Reject any application that does not satisfy the eligibility requirements.
- Cancel a scholarship if eligibility conditions are found to have been violated.
- Modify eligibility requirements if required due to changes in applicable regulations or administrative requirements.

Any such changes shall be communicated through the official PSAT communication channels.

Chapter Summary

Chapter 4: Registration Process

4.1 Introduction

PSAT 2026 follows a structured registration and selection process to ensure transparency, fairness, and equal opportunity for every applicant. Every candidate must successfully complete each stage of the process within the prescribed timelines. Failure to complete any mandatory step may result in cancellation of the application or scholarship eligibility.

Applicants are advised to regularly visit the official PSAT website and monitor their registered email address and mobile number for important updates.

4.2 PSAT Registration Journey

The scholarship journey consists of eight stages:

- 1. Registration
- 2. Application Verification
- 3. Admit Card
- 4. PSAT Examination
- 5. Result Declaration
- 6. Career Counselling
- 7. MBBS Abroad Admission
- 8. Scholarship Activation

Stage 1 - Online Registration

The registration process begins with the submission of the online application through the official PSAT website. Applicants shall visit the official PSAT website, click on "Register Now," verify their mobile number using OTP, create a secure password, complete the online registration form, and submit the application before the registration deadline.

Upon successful registration, every applicant shall receive:

- Registration Number
- Application ID
- Login Credentials
- Confirmation Email
- Confirmation SMS/WhatsApp Message

Information Required During Application

Personal Details: Full Name, Date of Birth, Gender, Category, Aadhaar Number (Optional at initial stage), Mobile Number, Email Address, State, City.

Academic Details: Class X Board, Class XII Board, PCB Percentage, School Name.

NEET Details: NEET Year, NEET Roll Number, NEET Score, NEET Percentile, AIR (If Available).

MBBS Abroad Preferences: Preferred Country, Approximate Budget, Passport Status, Parent/Guardian Details.

Scholarship Category: Applicants may select General Merit, Defence Scholarship, or Women in Medicine Scholarship. Supporting documents may be requested during verification.

Stage 2 - Application Verification

Once your application is complete and submitted, the PSAT Verification Team shall verify the submitted application. Verification includes Mobile Number Verification, Email Verification, Duplicate Application Check, NEET Qualification Verification, and Document Verification (where applicable). If discrepancies are found, applicants shall receive an opportunity to correct their application within the prescribed timeline. Only verified applications shall proceed to the examination stage.

Stage 3 - Admit Card

Applicants with successfully verified registrations shall be issued an electronic Admit Card containing Candidate Name, Registration Number, Photograph, Exam Date, Reporting Time, Login Instructions, and Examination Guidelines. Applicants must download their Admit Card from the official website. No candidate shall be permitted to appear for PSAT without a valid Admit Card.

Stage 4 - PSAT Scholarship Examination

Eligible candidates shall appear for the PSAT 2026 examination on the scheduled examination date. The examination shall be conducted online. Candidates must login before the reporting time, read all instructions carefully, complete identity verification (if applicable), and attempt the examination within the prescribed duration. Any unfair means or examination malpractice may result in immediate disqualification.

Stage 5 - Result Declaration

Following the examination, answer sheets shall be evaluated, merit scores shall be calculated, tie-breaking rules shall be applied where necessary, and shortlisted candidates shall be published on the official website. Candidates shall also receive an Individual Scorecard, Merit Rank, Scholarship Status, and Counselling Invitation (if shortlisted).

Stage 6 - Career Counselling

All shortlisted candidates shall be invited for a personalized counselling session with Pulse Education, including Career Assessment, University Shortlisting, Country Comparison, Budget Planning, NMC Compliance Guidance, Parent Counselling, Documentation Guidance, and Admission Roadmap. The objective is to help students make informed decisions regarding their MBBS Abroad journey.

Stage 7 - MBBS Abroad Admission Process

Candidates who decide to pursue admission through Pulse Education shall receive end-to-end admission assistance including University Selection, Application Submission, Offer Letter, Admission Confirmation, Fee Guidance, Visa Documentation, Visa Assistance, Travel Planning, and Pre-Departure Orientation. - Failure to meet the prescribed eligibility criteria.

Chapter 5: Pulse Scholarship Aptitude Test (PSAT) 2026

5.1 Introduction

PSAT 2026 is a national-level merit-based examination designed to identify deserving medical aspirants seeking financial assistance for pursuing MBBS Abroad. The examination assesses a candidate's conceptual understanding of Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, along with their ability to solve problems accurately under time constraints.

PSAT is not intended to replicate the NEET examination. Instead, it is designed to evaluate academic aptitude, conceptual clarity, and readiness for medical education through a balanced and transparent assessment process. The examination shall be conducted in accordance with the rules prescribed in this Information Bulletin.

5.3 Examination Pattern

The PSAT examination consists of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). Each question carries one mark. Candidates must select the most appropriate answer from the available options. Only one option shall be correct.

5.4 Duration

The total duration of the examination shall be 90 Minutes. The examination timer shall begin automatically after the candidate starts the examination. Once the allotted time expires, the examination shall be automatically

submitted. No additional time shall be provided except where specifically approved by the Scholarship Committee under exceptional circumstances.

5.5 Marking Scheme

Response	Marks

Candidates are advised to answer carefully, as incorrect responses attract negative marking.

5.6 Negative Marking

PSAT follows a negative marking system to encourage accuracy over guesswork. For every incorrect answer, 0.25 marks shall be deducted. No marks shall be deducted for questions left unanswered. Candidates should attempt only those questions for which they have reasonable confidence in the correct answer.

5.7 Difficulty Level

The overall examination shall be of Moderate to Difficult difficulty. Questions are designed to assess conceptual understanding, analytical ability, application of scientific principles, logical reasoning within Physics, Chemistry, and Biology, and accuracy under time pressure. The examination is intended to distinguish students based on merit while remaining fair and accessible to all eligible candidates.

5.8 Syllabus

The examination syllabus is broadly based on the NEET UG curriculum prescribed by the National Medical Commission (NMC). Questions may be asked from:

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to modify the syllabus if required.

5.9 Examination Language

The examination shall be conducted only in English. No regional language translations shall be provided. Candidates are advised to ensure they are comfortable attempting scientific questions in English.

5.10 Examination Platform

The PSAT examination shall be conducted through a secure online examination platform. Candidates shall require:

- Desktop or Laptop (Recommended)
- Stable Internet Connection
- Updated Web Browser
- Functional Keyboard and Mouse
- Webcam (if required)
- Quiet Examination Environment

Mobile phones are not recommended for attempting the examination.

5.11 Examination Instructions

- Login at least 30 minutes before the examination.
- Read all instructions carefully before beginning.
- Ensure uninterrupted internet connectivity.
- Attempt the examination independently.
- Avoid refreshing or closing the browser during the examination.
- Submit the examination before the timer expires.

5.12 Unfair Means

The following activities are strictly prohibited:

- Use of mobile phones for assistance
- Consulting books or study material
- Seeking help from another person
- Screen sharing
- Recording the examination
- Using AI tools or external software during the examination

- Any attempt to manipulate the examination platform

Any candidate found violating these rules may be immediately disqualified.

5.13 Passing Criteria

PSAT is a merit-based scholarship examination, not a qualifying examination. There is no fixed passing mark. Scholarships shall be awarded based on PSAT Score, NEET Qualification, Merit Ranking, Document Verification, and Compliance with Scholarship Eligibility Criteria. Candidates securing higher scores shall rank higher in the merit list.

The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to determine the merit cut-off depending on the number of applicants, overall performance, scholarship availability, and tie-break conditions.

5.14 Tie-Break Policy

If two or more candidates obtain identical scores, ranking shall be determined in the following order:

1. Higher Biology Score
2. Higher Chemistry Score
3. Higher Physics Score
4. Better NEET Score
5. Earlier Submission Time
6. Scholarship Committee Decision

The Committee's decision shall be final.

5.15 Examination Result

After evaluation, candidates shall receive their PSAT Score, Merit Rank, Scholarship Status, and Counselling Invitation (if shortlisted). Results shall be published on the official PSAT website.

7.4 Silver Scholar Award

Scholarship Value: Rs 75,000 · Number of Awards: One (1). Awarded to the candidate securing Rank 2.

The Scholarship Benefit shall remain valid only for the 2026 MBBS Abroad Admission Cycle. 8. Can repeaters apply?

Yes. Candidates who qualified NEET in 2024 or 2025 may apply, provided they meet all eligibility requirements.

9. Is there any age limit?

Candidates must satisfy the eligibility requirements applicable to MBBS Abroad under current NMC regulations and university admission policies.

10. Can OCI or foreign nationals apply?

No. PSAT 2026 is currently open only to Indian citizens.

C. Registration

11. Is registration free?

Yes. Registration for PSAT 2026 is free unless otherwise notified.

12. How do I register?

You can register through the official PSAT website by completing the online application form.

13. Can I edit my application after submission?

Corrections may be allowed during the designated correction window, if announced.

14. Can I submit multiple applications?

No. Only one application per candidate is permitted.

15. What happens if I submit multiple applications?

Multiple applications may result in rejection or cancellation of candidature.

D. Documents**16. Which documents are required?**

24. What is the language of the examination?

English.

25. Is the examination online?

Yes.

26. Can I use my mobile phone?

A laptop or desktop is recommended for the best experience.

F. Results**27. How are scholarships decided?**

Scholarships are awarded based on the PSAT Merit List, followed by verification and Scholarship Committee approval.

28. How is the merit list prepared?

Candidates are ranked according to their PSAT score.

29. Does my NEET score affect my scholarship?

NEET qualification is mandatory. The NEET score is used only as a tie-breaker if required.

30. Can I request re-evaluation?

No. Re-evaluation requests are not accepted.

31. Will I receive a scorecard?

We don't judge our students based on score, instead we'll be giving a participation certificate.

32. Will I receive a certificate?

Yes. Every candidate who appears for PSAT will receive a Digital Merit Certificate and Performance Report.
